RULES & REGULATIONS

- Classical selections (Classes I-XV) are those of a formal nature; no pop, musical theatre, or light opera will be accepted. Classical selections may include art songs, arias, and classically-set folk music.
- Graded selections (Classes IX-XII) must be from a Canadian Syllabus. Please specify the Canadian Examination Board and grade where asked.
- Musical Theatre and Light Opera selections (Classes XVI-XXI) may include musical theatre selections from stage, film, or light opera (composers such as Gilbert and Sullivan, Victor Herbert...). Selections must contrast in tempo and are to be sung CONCERT STYLE (no staging, costumes, or props).
- Selections for Class VIII need be of Grade 10 level or higher, but it is not required that they come from a syllabus.
- Students may enter a maximum of two classes.
- Classes IX-XII are designed for adult students who have more than three years of study, but who do not yet feel ready to enter classes VI-VIII.
- Current university students, advanced students, or students who are also teachers may not register for classes IX-XV. If this describes you, please register instead in the appropriate age category for classes I-VIII.
- All required fields on the registration forms MUST be completed before the form is submitted. This
 includes full titles, composers' names, and timing of selections. When listing an aria, please include
 the name of the opera or oratorio. When listing a musical theatre or light opera selection, please
 include the name of the production. Please be sure your form is complete before submission, and
 please check for proper spelling.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- No changes or substitutions may be made after the deadline. Anyone performing selections that were
 not listed on the entry form will be disqualified from placement and will sing for adjudication only. No
 refunds will be issued should the singer cancel his or her participation.
- We reserve the right to divide any class deemed too large.
- Each class will be adjudicated by three adjudicators.
- In the event of a first place tie, there will be a sing-off. In this event, the adjudicators will select one selection from each singer to hear again and adjudicate. The winner of the sing-off will receive first place and the remaining singer(s) will receive or tie for second place.

- No changes or substitutions may be made after the deadline.
- Classes may be scheduled from 9am Friday, 07 March until 9pm Saturday, 08 March. Please indicate only work-related or unavoidable critical conflicts for student or accompanist. The committee will make an effort to accommodate these conflicts, but accommodation cannot be guaranteed. Schedule conflicts will not be considered after the deadline.
- Registration fees are as follows:
 - Students of registered NATS members: \$40/class
 - Students of teachers who are not NATS members: \$50/class
